BHARAT VANDANA PARK TURNS INTO KILLING FIELDS OF "NEELGAI", COURTSEY NBCC; ADRF DEMANDS LEGAL ACTION

Home Minister Shri Amit Shah, laid the foundation stone of Bharat Vandana Park at Sector 20, Dwarka, New Delhi. The other dignitaries present on the occasion were S/Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Union Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA); Anil Baijal, Lieutenant Governor of Delhi; Manoj Tiwari, Member of Parliament; Tarun Kapoor, VC, DDA; P K Gupta, CMD NBCC and other senior officials.

The Multifaceted world-class theme park valuing approximately Rs. 524 crore is being developed by DDA and NBCC, has been appointed as Project Management Consultant for the project who have to execute the project from concept to commissioning.

When the plan was proposed, environmentalists and some local residents had opposed it, as they wanted the area to be developed as a biodiversity park, Robin Sharma, social activist and a resident of Dwarka, said, "This area had a natural water body and was natural habitat for Neelgais, Rabbit, Deer & many species of birds. The green space has been destroyed by NBCC officials. Robin said the social activists

of Dwarka requested PK Gupta CMD NBCC to protect helpless animals but no action was taken ,resulting in the death of some Neelgais. Robin said because of the construction the natural water body has been destroyed so the Neelgais & other animals often come on road and they meet with accidents.

Shobhit Chauhan noted environmentalist & resident of Dwarka said that a calf of Neelgai met with accident and the matter was reported to CMD NBCC but no action was taken. A group of animal lovers tried their level best to save



the life of calf but despite all efforts the calf died. Shobhit said many animals lost their life but NBCC didn't bother to save the animals & waterbody.

Robin said we are not against Bharat Vandana Park but we want NBCC to protect Neelgais and other animals. NBCC must come forward and make arrangements to transfer the animals to some jungle or zoo. According to documents available with Dwarka Express a police complaint has been lodged against PK Gupta CMD NBCC and other competent officials.

Dwarka Express spoke to Aiit Swami ,President All Dwarka Residents Federation and he said that NBCC is a very responsible institute but such inhuman behaviour not only defames NBCC but also poses serious questions on GOI claim about protection of wildlife in India. Ajit Swami said NBCC must take appropriate action to protect NEELGAIS & other animals and must issue white paper citing till date how many animals were killed because of their inefficiency.

Nilgai, the orphaned wildlife of Dwarka!

Nilgai (Boselaphus tragocamelusas) as the name suggests, is a BLUE BULL that is found mostly in North India. It is a peculiar species. It cannot be defined as a deer or a bull actually. In Science, Nilgai is classified as an ANTELOPE. It is called blue bull because the male Nilgai is greyish blue in colour though the female is brownish. These animals are seen in herds that roam in the scrub jungles of northern states like Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. But like other buffaloes and bulls they run berserk and, in the process, hit someone unknowingly. This makes the animal hostile to the mankind. But poor animals do not want anything from human beings except a shelter in the scrub jungles. There are only a few antelopes in the world out of which we can find a few other species in India like Black Buck (remember Salman Khan?), Chinkara Gazelle, and Chousingha (Four Horned Antelope).



These are in fact neglected lot, though they are protected under Wildlife Protection Act. Killing or harming these animals are banned. But the fact that they are herbivorous and not strong enough to fight back the predators like tigers and leopards often control their population which is part of the natural selection as per Darwinism. Yes, now we are coming to Dwarka New Delhi where these poor Nilgais have lost their home. We are talking about Bharat Vandhana Park and other nearby scrub jungles inside Dwarka and Najafgarh. Bharat Vandhana, a potential biodiversity park has been totally destructed and is being replaced by an amusement park by DDA in collaboration with NBCC, which is just a construction company. The might has won over the right despite strong protests by NGOs like Green Circle. They could destroy Bharat Vandhana, the habitat of 27+ Nilgais which ran helter-skelter in order to save themselves from the roaring giant machines that invaded the park. We wonder how the contractors comfortably forgotten the tenets of Wildlife Protection Act 1972 (Schedule III) which ensures protection to Nilgais, specifically. For abandoning the wildlife and destruction of their habitat, criminal actions are liable to be initiated against the agencies which are now busy with the so-called mini-India Amusement Park. Not only the Nilgais were victims, there are many more flora and fauna like monitor lizards, micro organisms, a natural water body and rich grassland which was home to many more small birds and butterflies

Proximity to Najafgarh Nala perpetual source of trouble for Shahjahanabad Society

S h a h j a h a n a b a d Society is located on the very first plot of Sector-11 Dwarka.

It is adjacent to Najafgarh Nala. The entire eastern boundary wall of Shah-jahanabad runs parallel to this Nala.

Such close proximity to this massive drain has been a perpetual source of trouble for Shahjahanabadians.

Amongst many problems we are facing due to this Nala, the most nagging one is the dumping of constructions waste (Debris / Malba) beside our boundary wall.

In fact, just a few months back all the accumulated heaps of debris were painstakingly removed by hiring a JCB machine.

The wilderness area was properly cleared-up and pavement was laid

using interlocking cement tiles.

This pavement is now being extensively used by morning/evening walkers from all the adjoining Societies like Rama, Gold Croft, Appu Enclave, and by people going to nearby Dwarka Mosque to pray.

However, of late, this illegal dumping has been started again by unscrupulous builders.

Anytime construction work is done in flats of the adjoining Societies, the waste so generated in the form of broken tiles, stripped wall plaster, broken toilet seats or washbasins, spoilt cement / POP bags get dumped on the newly constructed pavement.

These miscreants know well that dumping such debris in that area is strictly prohibited and is a punishable offense yet they manage to sneak in and discard such filth in a clandestine manner.

Needless to say that such scattered filth is a major eyesore and a serious health hazard.

Ideally, any construction waste generated should only be discarded in the MCD demarcated area (Landfill Site).

Such sites are present in Goyla Diary Area in Sector 19 which is quite far from Sector 11.

Thus instead of hiring tractor-trolley operators who charge a substantial amount for proper disposal of debris on these distant landfill sites, building con-




tractors or individual flat owners hire Thela Walas (cycle-cart pushers) to stealthily dump the waste on the pavement with impunity.

Since administration never bothered to take any action in this matter previously, Shahjahanabad is planning to install CCTV cameras on the boundary wall with the hope that it will act as a deterrent.

These cameras would be pointed and dedicated to capturing any activity in the vicinity of the aforementioned drain area leading all the way to the Mosque.

To strike the fear of being caught redhanded notice boards would be placed at prominent locations along the pavement declaring that the entire area is under strict surveillance, discarding any debris is strictly prohibited, and would be dealt with an iron fist.

Medical Breakthroughs: New GQ-RCP platform to detect SARS-CoV-2 by fluorescence readout

The COVID19 Pandemic has shown how viruses can potentially wreak havoc and are a global threat to human health. The current Covid-19 pandemic caused by SARS-CoV-2 continues to inflict catastrophic effects on all aspects of our lives.

The saving grace from such disasters comes from innovation and constant development in the medical field.

India has taken a step in the right direction with a group of scientists from Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR) who have developed a new platform for fluorometric detection of pathogens such as viruses using measurements of fluorescent light emitted by them.

The novel technology developed by them has been proved in the detection of SARS-CoV-2.

The unprecedented transmission rate of the RNA virus has necessitated rapid and accurate diagnosis to facilitate contact tracing, prevent further spread and provide timely treatment to the affected individuals.

GQ-RCP platform to diagnose Covid-19 clinical samples


The group of scientists from JN-CASR, an autonomous institute of the Department of Science & Technology and IISc (India Institute of Science), have demonstrated a noncanonical nucleic acid-based G-quadruplex (GQ) topology targeted reliable conformational polymorphism (GQ-RCP) platform to diagnose Covid-19 clinical samples.

– What are G-quadruplex structures? G-quadruplexes are noncanonical nucleic acid structures formed from stacked guanine tetrads. They are frequently used as building blocks and functional elements in fields such as synthetic biology and are also thought to play widespread biological roles.

This work has been published recently in the journal 'ACS Sensors' and the team has also filed a patent for the novel technology.

The current work has demonstrated the first GQ-targeted diagnostic platform for SARS-CoV-2 in clinical samples, based on a novel platform GQ-RCP. This molecular detection platform can be integrated into field-deployable isothermal amplification assays with more reliability and sequence specificity.

To achieve stable and dependable noncanonical DNA/RNA targets, the platform places a larger emphasis on deciphering and systematic characterization of a unique set of interactions in nucleic acids. The RCP-based target validation methodology is a generic and modular method for developing noncanonical nucleic acid-targeted diagnostic tools for a wide range of diseases, including bacteria and



DNA/RNA viruses.

How is this technology different and better?

In most parts, RT-q-PCR has been the gold standard for accurate detection of SARS-CoV-2 (Covid-19).

In some of the most recent innovations on the nucleic acid-targeted diagnosis of SARS-CoV-2, the techniques such as RT RPA and RT-LAMP use general-purpose DNA sensing probes. This in turn increases the chances of false-positive results arising out of unbiased detection of nonspecific amplification products.

Therefore, recognizing unique DNA secondary conformations can be a promising solution to achieve reliable readouts.

The team has identified and characterized a unique G-quadruplex-based target derived from the 30 kb (kilobytes) genomic landscape of SARS-CoV-2 for specific detection of SARS-CoV-2. In contrast to other reliable diagnostic assays where the existing fundamental concepts have been

repurposed, the GQ-RCP platform provides a completely novel strategy to target a unique, unconventional structure specific to the SARS-CoV-2 sequence using small molecule fluorophores (microscopic molecules).

The mechanisms of this technology
The team of scientists developing this
GQ topology targeted detection of
SARS-CoV-2 derived DNA obtained
after reverse transcription and amplification from genomic RNA in clinical
samples

They successfully demonstrated GQ targeted detection by the pH-triggered facile transformation of the amplified double-stranded DNA into stable GQs, which forms the target for detection with remarkable selectivity using a designed fluorescent dye which is a benzobisthiazole-based target-specific turn on called BTMA.

Thus, this study demonstrates a reliable strategy for fluorogenic organic molecule-based GQ-RCP platform to diagnose Covid-19 clinical samples and is also the first practical demon-

stration of this method.

The team notes that relying on viruses' unique nucleic acid conformations to generate particular diagnostic assays with reliable read-outs is an attractive approach. Molecular probes with superior conformation or sequences for particular recognition of nucleic acids would solve the problem of false-positive detection findings in current approaches.

Since the RCP-based platform is very general, it can be easily adapted for the detection of various DNA/RNA based pathogens including bacteria and viruses such as HIV, Influenza, HCV, etc.


Birding is not just a pleasure but a mission to save environment



For Muralidhar, Co-founder of Green Circle, Bird watching is not just a hobby it is much more than that. Retired from a Bank, Muralidhar is devoting his time in environmental activities and bird photography. He has recently visited Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary and photographed many migratory birds. Dwarka Express contacted him to know how he was dragged into Bird Photography. I have been a trekker and mountaineer for the last 4 decades. I have trekked Leh Ladak several times. All along I have been a Nature Photographer. Birds always fascinated me though I took to serious birding after joining Green Circle and got connected to Selvarajan, our founder Secretary.

Sharing his experience about the birding in Bharatpur, he added, "like every year, last week, few of our Green Circle members visited Bharatpur and we have number of migratory birds which flock to the numerous Wetlands of Bharatpur Bird Sanctuary located in Rajasthan. Once inside this Sanctuary, you are transported to another world altogether - the thick scrub jungle is home to literally hundreds of species of birds, mammals and reptiles. Birds from other parts of the world migrate here for breeding and feeding as well. On every visit to the Sanctuary here, you learn and discover something new. The unique feature here are undoubtedly the licensed rickshaw puller who also doubles up as a guide, can rattle off names of species in Hindi, English and few of them can tell the German and French names too! They will also give added details of origin of the migratory species"

Some of the birds we spotted this year include Northern Shovellers, Pintails, Black headed Ibis, Pelicans and



Coots besides resident birds like cormorants and kingfishers. From Green Circle, we have already started checklisting birds in Dwarka. Several migratory birds like Red-breasted flycatcher, black Redstart, Gadwal, Northern Shoveller visit Dwarka also.

"Samarpan Diwas" to Commemorate Death **Anniversary of Pt Deen Dayal Upadhyay**

Pt Deendayal Upadhyaya (25 September 1916 - 11 February 1968) was an Indian politician, proponent of Hindutva ideology espoused by the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). Pt Deendayal Upadhyaya started the monthly publication Rashtra Dharma, broadly meaning 'National Duty', in the 1940s to spread the ideology of nationalism with the motive of Ek Bharat -Shreshth Bharat . Upadhyaya is known for drafting Jan Sangh's official political doctrine, Integral humanism, by including some cultural-nationalism values ,progress of all and swadeshi.



In December 1967, Upadhyaya was elected president of the BJS. In the evening of 10 February 1968, at Lucknow he boarded the Sealdah Express for Patna. The train reached Mughalsarai at about 2:10 am but Upadhyaya was not on it. His body was found near Mughalsarai Junction railway station in Uttar Pradesh 10 minutes after the train arrived, lying near a traction pole 748 feet from the end of the platform where the train halted. He was clutching a five-rupee note in his hand. The BJP workers alleged that the then congress government was involved in gruesome murder of Pt DeenDayal Upadhyay and they demanded a CBI probe in this matter.
